SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT FOR OCCIDENTAL CHEMICAL CORPORATION RETIREE MEDICAL PLAN

This is a summary of the annual report of the Occidental Chemical Corporation Retiree Medical Plan, EIN 16-0484732, Plan No. 600, for the period January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, U.S. Department of Labor, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Occidental Chemical Corporation has committed itself to pay a portion of the medical claims incurred under the terms of the plan.

Insurance Information

For certain participants the plan has contracts with Aetna Health Inc., Blue Cross Blue Shield of Michigan and Independence Blue Cross to pay medical claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending December 31, 2023 were \$1,182,809.

Because they are so called "experience-rated" contracts, the premium costs are affected by, among other things, the number and size of claims. Of the total insurance premiums paid for the plan year ending December 31, 2023, the premiums paid under such "experience-rated" contracts were \$678,266 and the total of all benefit claims paid under these contracts during the plan year was \$16,719.
